Partner/project host/ project overview

In every country Tanzania included there are unfortunately many children who have been abandoned to their own luck, Orphans, born in homes with no love, abused, or suffer poverty and sickness. These children need a loving heart, attention, education and friends who can help them find a better life full of opportunities, be successful and most important have happiness life. Anita’s Memorial Day care-center is an initiative established to honor dreams and vision of a young lady the Late Anita Mlay who has an intention to establish children center to support vulnerable children in her community but she passed away at a very early age before realizing her dream.

Child’s Safer place is a project aiming to increase the overall wellbeing of the children in the community through various approaches. The overall goal is to provide a safe place for children of all ability during the day to spend their time while their parents are in work, accessible services for children from low-income families and children, disabilities and those who are vulnerable. The project started in 2024 and currently have 15 children at the center and the number is expecting to raise in 2025. The age of the children is from 2 to 5 years old.

Description of work

You will engage in various activities aiming to develop the child, but provide safe place outside home. This will include: -

- Social skills: To train kids to understand basic social skills that will help them to interact well with other people, manner etc.
- Basic childcare: Monitoring children to ensure they remain safe as they go about their activities.
- Homebased services: Visting children with special needs and encourage parents to bring them to the centre.
- Other activities: Organize activities which will help the kids to relax but also learn. This may include games, sports, Arts, Craft, Music classes, Movie/ cartoon watching etc.

Food & accommodation

Volunteer(s) will be accommodated at the host family in the community a walking distance from the Children Center. Foord will be provided in the host family and sometimes at the project site where vegetarian meals will be available for volunteers in need. You are expected to be part of the family by joining other household activities like cleaning, cooking etc.



Location & leisure activities

The project is located at Usa River township in the outskirts of Arusha city. It is a new developed neighborhood with people of various cultural backgrounds due to the expansions of Arusha city. The community is found right at the slopes of Mount Meru, the second tallest Mountain in Tanzania after Kilimanjaro. The place is accessible by public and private transport from Arusha city and Kilimanjaro airport. All social services are available. Arusha is known as the capital of tourism but also the capital city of the East African community [EAC] in this regard, there will be a good number of leisure activities options that includes wildlife safari, Mountain trekking, eco and cultural tourism.

Many parents choose center-based care because they believe the presence of multiple caregivers, larger groups of children, and state inspections make them both safer and more dependable. Chamazi day-care Centers are set of projects include a number children day care centers aiming to **ensure that children receive a good quality childhood care, education and gains the skills and knowledge they need to thrive achieve promising future. Partner/project host/ project overview

This project will be hosted by the Lutheran sub-Parish Lolarash which is intending to address provide early childhood accessibility to all children in the community. Distance travelled to school every day by pupil has substantial adverse effects on attendance at school. Younger children at the age of 4-6 are often the most vulnerable to access early childhood educational centers. Walking several kilometers every day is more strenuous for a small child than a teenager. Schools are located further from children's homes. These factors among many others create significant barriers preventing millions of the world's younger children from attending school. This project is aiming to renovate old church building into day care center where young children from the community can access early childhood education. It is also aiming to provide extracurricular activities for students after school hours.

Description of work

- Renovation: This will include manual work (Making new floor, partitioning rooms, painting and cement mixing);
- Children games (children's Indoor and outdoor games that will stimulate learning, team building and activeness. Local games will be introduced as well foreign ones from the volunteers. Please bring new games to share with Kids);
- Nature activities (Bird watching, plant a tree, Tree feeder, learning about various plants, birds, animals, worms, and insects available in the area); and academic development activities (After school hour home works, various competitions aiming to motivate children's academic development).

Food & accommodation
