**DEVELOPMENT**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION & ACTIVITIES: Volunteers get involved in teaching baby classes, pre-care, pre-unit and class one (1) to class eight (8) for pre & primary school. Secondary schools; Teach secondary school subjects ie Maths, English, biology, chemistry, languages ie French, Japanese. The volunteers will get involved in lesson planning and timetable structuring, testing and examining. **PROJECT DESCRIPTION & ACTIVITIES**: Health care remains a challenge to many families in Africa, due to poverty and inequality in distribution of economic resources coupled

with low development of health infrastructures. Africa remains behind in fulfilling health requirement to its inhabitants and Kenya is no exception, especially in rural areas where this position will be located.

Volunteers will be involved in extension clinical services to various villages within the communities of vihiga County.

This will involve medical camps and provision of medical services (basic) to local poor household who cannot afford hospital care through:

- Forming relationships and collaboration with government owned health facilities, i.e. dispensaries and health centres
- Development of health procedures to be followed by trained community health volunteers to enable the project and service more sustainable
- Carry out health talks, hygiene, sanitation, sex education at public primary school and secondary schools
- Participate in open HIV/AIDS testing and counseling
- Participate in weekly youth health talk and formation of youth health focused groups
- Child health care/orphan support, counseling and nutrition education
