Let's make women* more visible on Wikipedia!

Only 17% of all biographies on the English language Wikipedia are about women – and 90% of all contributors to Wikipedia are men, even though it is a volunteering project that is open to everybody. We want to change that! In this project, we will learn how to write Wikipedia articles and will get to know the inspiring biographies of amazing activists fighting for peace, environmental justice, LGBT+ rights, civil rights and other burning issues to make our planet a better place.

About the camp

We will be a group of 20 young people living in Armenia, Austria, Germany and Spain. From 2^{nd} to 10^{th} August 2019, we will live together in a simple hostel in

Kötschach-Mauthen, a small mountain village in the Austrian Alps. Our common language will be English. Apart from editing Wikipedia and discussing gender equality, we will cook together, go hiking and get to know each other.

The camp is organised by Wikimedia Austria, the Austrian chapter of the worldwide non-profit foundation behind Wikipedia together with SCI-Germany. The project is funded by the European Commission through Erasmus+.

Who can join?

- Anybody between 18 and 30 years old
- People who reside in Germany
- Being interested in feminism, gender equality and social justice & enjoying writing

You don't need to be experienced in Wikipedia, have any specific technical skills or speak perfect English – if you do, that's great. We explicitly encourage people of all gender identities, sexual orientations and ethnic backgrounds to apply.



Financial conditions

Selected participants will be asked to pay a placement fee of 80€ (70€ for SCI members). Travel costs will be reimbursed in amounts:

- Up to 180€ for participants who travel less than 500 kilometers from their home to the place of

project

 Up to 275€ for participants who travel more than 500 kilometers from their home to the place of project.

Food, accommodation and all the other project related expenses are fully covered for selected participants by the project's grant.
